Dear Wildcat Family,

The end of the first nine weeks is quickly approaching and we need your help to make teaching decisions to know how many students will be returning to Brick and Mortar. We have already heard from some families that want to return. If you are planning to return to Wiles (Brick and Mortar) please email your intention to wilesregistration@gm.sbac.edu by Thursday, October 29th at noon.

We are sending home Emergency Contact Cards for every Brick and Mortar student at Wiles today. When you receive your card, please make sure you check over it carefully, make ANY corrections needed, sign and date it and return it to school by Monday, October 26th. For your child's safety and protection, we must have an Emergency Card on file for every student.

On Monday, October 26th there will a School-based Input Meeting for rezoning for Elementary School I. Wiles meeting is scheduled from 6:00 - 8:00 pm. If you just want to watch as it happens or watch it later, we would ask that you go to the District's YouTube channel

to watch, as large Zoom meetings can be difficult to manage when not used primarily as a presentation method. There is a capacity of 100 participants in the Zoom meeting, so if you do join the Zoom meeting to ask a question, we would ask that you then switch back to YouTube for the rest of the meeting. The YouTube feed runs about 15 - 20 seconds behind the meeting, so you should not miss anything by switching over. Also, if you are unable to ask a question or make a suggestion during the meeting, the District has a form you can submit online to provide feedback at <https://fl02219191.schoolwires.net/Page/30165>, and questions can still be asked by emailing rezoning@gm.sbac.edu. There will also be an in-person meeting at the district offices from 4:00 pm to 8:00 pm on Wednesday, November 4th. The live Zoom link is
